

RESOLUTION FOR TROOPER EDWARD LOWRY AND DEPUTY SHERIFF DAVID HATHCOCK

WHEREAS, North Carolina State Highway Patrol Trooper Edward Lowry and Cumberland County Deputy Sheriff David Hathcock were admired law enforcement officers who dedicated themselves to protecting the lives and property of the public; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Lowry and Deputy Sheriff Hathcock were natives of Cumberland County and had made the county their home; and

WHEREAS, On September 27, 1997, Trooper Lowry and Deputy Sheriff Hathcock were killed on Interstate 95 trying to make the highways of Cumberland County and North Carolina safe for all motorists; and


WHEREAS, the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners and the town of Hope Mills have requested the North Carolina Board of Transportation honor Trooper Lowry and Deputy Sheriff Hathcock.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name the bridges on N.C. 59 over Interstate 95 in Cumberland County in honor of North Carolina State Highway Patrol Trooper Edward Lowry and Cumberland County Deputy Sheriff David Hathcock for their selfless dedication to protect the citizens of Cumberland County, North Carolina and all those who use the state's highways.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
