NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

RESOLUTION FOR TROOPER HARRY T. LONG

WHEREAS, on December 18, 1959, North Carolina Highway Patrol Trooper Harry T. Long was struck and killed by a vehicle on U.S. 301 in Harnett County; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Long became the 19th member of the North Carolina Highway Patrol to lose his life in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the Harnett County and Lillington Boards of Commissioners have passed resolutions asking the N.C. Board of Transportation to honor Trooper Long; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. 401 bridge crossing the Cape Fear River is located within the municipal boundaries of the Town of Lillington in Harnett County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the N.C. Board of Transportation names the bridge on U.S. 401 over the Cape Fear River in Lillington the *Trooper Harry T. Long Bridge* for his dedication and sacrifice for the safety and well-being of North Carolina citizens.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.

Adopted, this the second day of October 1998, by the North Carolina Board of Transportation.
