Approval – Resolution for Trooper Kyle Barber

Upon a recommendation from the Road Naming Committee a motion was made by

Board Member Halsey, which was seconded by Board Member White to approve the following:

WHEREAS, Trooper Kyle Barber served the North Carolina Highway Patrol, Troop F, District 2 Patrol Office in Wilkesboro from January 1995 until his untimely death on May 19, 2009; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Kyle Barber, while in the line of duty, was involved in two separate accidents within a two-year period causing him numerous injuries and surgeries, which resulted in his death: and

WHEREAS, Trooper Kyle Barber was a leading citizen, an outstanding law enforcement officer and dedicated to the welfare of the citizens of Wilkes County; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Kyle Barber served on the Wilkes Telephone Board of Directors and Shepherds Crossroads Volunteer Fire Department Board of Directors as well as coaching girls soccer at the East Wilkes High School; and

WHEREAS, the Wilkes County Board of Commissioners requested the North Carolina Department of Transportation honor the memory of Trooper Kyle Barber for his dedication and service to his community.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name the bridge on U.S. 421 over Red, White and Blue Road (S.R. 2325) in Wilkes County, as the *Trooper Kyle Barber Bridge*.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
