A RESOLUTION FOR TROOPER M.L.MARTIN

WHEREAS, Trooper M.L. Martin was born on November 23, 1962; and

WHEREAS, he was a native of Mount Olive, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Martin was a member of the North Carolina Highway Patrol who performed his duties admirably for four years, assigned to Troop D, District 3, in Rockingham County; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Highway Patrol provides law enforcement on our state's highways; and

WHEREAS, on July 22, 1988, Trooper M.L. Martin lost his life in Rockingham County in the performance of his duties for the Highway Patrol; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Highway Patrol and the citizens of Wayne County feel that it is important to keep alive the memory of this community-minded individual,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

That the bridge on U.S. 117 over N.C. 55 in Mount Olive, North Carolina be dedicated in honor of Trooper M.L. Martin.

That the N.C. Department of Transportation erect appropriate signs for such dedication.
