

RESOLUTION FOR TROOPER PETE PETERSON

WHEREAS, Trooper Pete Peterson was a highly respected member of the North Carolina Highway Patrol; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Pete Peterson served the citizens of Rutherford County and North Carolina by protecting their lives and property; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Pete Peterson was killed in the line of duty on May 31, 1979; and


WHEREAS, the Rutherford County Board of Commissioners unanimously requested the North Carolina Department of Transportation honor Trooper Pete Peterson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names the bridge carrying traffic on U.S. 221 over U.S. 74 in Rutherford County the *Trooper Pete Peterson Bridge* for his dedicated service and for his ultimate sacrifice that made the highways in Rutherford County and the state safer for all motorists.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
