A RESOLUTION FOR TROOPER RAYMOND EARL WORLEY

WHEREAS, Trooper Raymond Earl Worley was born March 24, 1942; and

WHEREAS, he was a native of Currituck County, a graduate of Dr. W.T. Griggs High School in Popular Branch, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Worley was a member of the North Carolina Highway Patrol who performed his duties admirably for twenty-three years, assigned to Troop A, District 1 in Northampton County; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Highway Patrol provides law enforcement on our state's highways; and

WHEREAS, on May 14, 1985, Trooper Raymond Earl Worley lost his life in Halifax County in the performance of his duties for the Highway Patrol; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Highway Patrol and the citizens of Currituck County feel that it is important to keep alive the memory of this community-minded individual,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

That the two-mile section of N.C. 3 from Bertha to Popular Branch in Currituck County be dedicated in honor of Trooper Raymond Earl Worley.

That the N.C. Department of Transportation erect appropriate signs for such dedication.
