However, a motion was made by Board Member Garrison that the Board pursue all avenues in an effort to secure emergency federal assistance in the repair of system roads, specifying documented information is to be prepared by the Highway Division Engineers in support of this request and should be forthcoming by May 1st. The motion was seconded by Board Member Ledford and unanimously carried.

Adoption - Resolution Naming Bridge over the Tar River on US 264 in Pitt County the "W. Arthur Tripp Bridge"

Secretary Bradshaw advised the Pitt County Board of Commissioners and the Legislators representing Pitt County have requested the bridge over the Tar River on US 264 Bypass east of Greenville be named in memory of Mr. W. Arthur Tripp, and presented a resolution for consideration.

Accordingly, a motion was made by Board Member Bumgardner, seconded by Board Member Garrison, and the vote was unanimous that the Board adopt resolution naming bridge in memory of Mr. Tripp.

"WHEREAS, the Board of Transportation has received a resolution from the Pitt County Board of Commissioners to name the bridge over the Tar River located on US 264 Bypass east of Greenville, North Carolina, in memory of Mr. W. Arthur Tripp; and

"WHEREAS, The entire legislative delegation representing Pitt County has endorsed the resolution of the Pitt County Board of Commissioners; and
