

RESOLUTION FOR W. CLIFF MARTIN

WHEREAS, W. Cliff Martin has been a long time Anson County resident and civic and community leader; and

WHEREAS, W. Cliff Martin has worked diligently and effectively as Mayor of Polkton for 46 years; and

WHEREAS, W. Cliff Martin has been instrumental in developing and implementing crucial economic and civic projects in and surrounding the Polkton area; and

WHEREAS, W. Cliff Martin has been a trustee of Anson Community College for 28 years and currently is President of Anson Technical College Foundation; served as vice-chairman of the Economic Development Commission; served on the Anson County Hospital Board for 22 years (causing an amendment to be adopted to extend the usual 12 year term so he could serve 10 more years); and

WHEREAS, W. Cliff Martin received the Paul Harris Fellow Award from the Wadesboro Rotary Club; is a lifetime member of the Anson County Historical Society; a World War II veteran; and is an elder of Hawley Memorial Presbyterian Church; and

WHEREAS, W. Paul Martin has devoted his life selflessly to the advancement and betterment of Polkton and Anson County for over 40 years; and

WHEREAS, the Anson County Board of Commissioners, the Polkton City Council as well as civic and community organizations requested the North Carolina Department of Transportation to honor W. Cliff Martin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name US 74 from Union County Line to Wadesboro "W. Cliff Martin Highway" to honor the long-time Anson County resident for his dedication and commitment.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
