

NAMING OF NC 704

On June 20, 1984 the North Carolina General Assembly ratified a resolution to name NC 704 as the "Wesley D. Webster Highway". A copy of the resolution is attached.

NC 704 extends from NC 65 west of Wentworth in Rockingham County to NC 89 southeast of Francisco in Stokes County - a distance of 39 miles.

Pursuant to the provisions of G. S. 136-18(8) it is recommended the Board of Transportation concur in the naming of NC 704 as the "WESLEY D. WEBSTER HIGHWAY" and authorize the Department of Transportation to erect appropriate signs.

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 772
