WHEREAS, William D. Goldston, Jr. of Rockingham County has served in the North Carolina Senate since 1983; and

WHEREAS, William D. Goldston, Jr. has a record of supporting good roads for the people of North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, William D. Goldston, Jr. served on the Highway Study Commission from 1987 to 1989; and

WHEREAS, William D. Goldston, Jr. was a legislative leader in the sucessful effort to enact the Highway Trust Fund Law; and

WHEREAS, The Highway Trust Fund Law will complete the North Carolina Intrastate System, construct multi-lane connector roads and loops near seven North Carolina cities, pave 10,000 miles of secondary roads by 1999 and provide additional money to cities for their streets; and

WHEREAS, Board of Transportation member Seddon Goode, Jr. fully supports the recognition of William D. Goldston, Jr. for his contributions to transportation in North Carolina.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That through the direction of the North Carolina Board of Transportation, a section of NC-14 in Rockingham County which is to be specified at a future date is hereby designated as the "William D. Goldston, Jr. Highway."
- 2. That the Department of Transportation is ordered to erect appropriate signs at a suitable time.
