A motion was made by Board Member Burnette, seconded by Board Member Hollers, and the vote was unanimous to approve the recommendations as outlined by Administrator Rose.

III Approval - Naming of Bridge on US 17 over the Dismal Swamp Canal in Camden County the "William Ira Halstead Bridge"

Administrator Rose advised the Department of Transportation has received a request from the Camden County Board of Commissioners to name the new dual bridges now under construction on US 17 over the Dismal Swamp Canal the "William Ira Halstead Bridge". He noted the resolution expressed the opinion that it would be a great honor to a former citizen of Camden County who was an outstanding attorney, legislator and superior court judge who died on November 19, 1963 after a lifetime of service to his community, county and state.

A motion was made by Board Member Basnight, seconded by Board Member Joyner, and the vote was unanimous to approve the name "William Ira Halstead Bridge" for the new dual bridges on US 17 over the Dismal Swamp Canal at South Mills and authorize the Department to erect appropriate signs.

Approval - Allocation from "Reserve for Emergencies, Unforeseen Events, and Public Access Roads"

Administrator Rose noted on September 11, 1981, the Board allocated \$186,000 from the "Reserve for Emergencies, Unforeseen Events and Public Access Roads" to improve highway drainage in the Nags Head/Kill Devil Hills area. He said these funds have been expended; however, they were not sufficient to take care of all the critical flood areas. Mr. Rose reviewed the critical situation and said due to the continuing
