

RESOLUTION FOR OFFICER ROBERT Y CLEMENT BRIDGE

WHEREAS, the Rowan County Board of Commissioners finds it would be fitting and proper to honor the memory of slain police officer, Robert Young Clement. Officer Clement was a Rowan County resident and a member of the Spencer Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Officer Clement is remembered as a kind and generous man who loved his family, friends and co-workers; and

WHEREAS, Officer Clement died on June 3, 1999, after he was shot while performing his duties protecting the citizens of Rowan County; and

WHEREAS, the Rowan County Board of Commissioners wishes to memorialize Officer Clement for his career in law enforcement, for his dedicated service and sacrifice to his country, to the state of North Carolina and to the citizens of Rowan County; and

WHEREAS, the Rowan County Board of Commissioners hereby requests that the North Carolina Board of Transportation names Bridge #141 on Stokes Ferry Road (SR 1004) over South Second Creek in Salisbury in honor of Officer Robert Young Clement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names Bridge #141 on Stokes Ferry Road (SR 1004) over South Second Creek in Salisbury as the *Officer Robert Y Clement Bridge*.

That appropriate signs will be erected at a suitable time.
