

RESOLUTION FOR CORPORAL HENRY F WARNER BRIDGE

WHEREAS, Montgomery County desires to honor native son, Henry F. "Lowe" Warner, who made the ultimate sacrifice protecting fellow soldiers in the Second World War; and

WHEREAS, Warner was awarded the country's highest and most prestigious military honor, the Medal of Honor, for his heroism; and

WHEREAS, the family of Warner supports the naming of the bridge in his honor; and

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners supports and requests the North Carolina Board of Transportation to name the new bridge spanning Little River on N.C. 24/27 (Bob Jordan Highway) in honor of Henry F. "Lowe" Warner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names the N.C. 24/27 bridge over Little River in Montgomery County as the *Corporal Henry F Warner Bridge*.

That appropriate signs will be erected at a suitable time.
