

RESOLUTION FOR WILLIAM M SUE BRIDGE

WHEREAS, William M. Sue was born and raised in Leland, N.C. in northern Brunswick County and is a current resident of Leland; and

WHEREAS, Sue served 18 years on the Brunswick County Board of Commissioners, serving as its Chairman for five of those years, and served on the Brunswick County Board of Education for eight years prior to his terms on the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, during his first term as a County Commissioner, Sue made a presentation to the North Carolina Board of Transportation requesting that Interstate 140 (then known as the Wilmington Bypass) be completed as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, Sue was an active member of the advisory committee of the Wilmington Metropolitan Planning Organization and continually advocated for construction of I-140 in northern Brunswick County; and

WHEREAS, Sue was honored by becoming a member of the Order of the Long Leaf Pine in 2011; and

WHEREAS, Sue has been a tireless advocate for the needs of the people of Brunswick County, serving in numerous other public and civic organizations for several decades; and

WHEREAS, the Brunswick County Board of Commissioners requests that the North Carolina Department of Transportation name the I-140 bridge over U.S. 74/76 in Brunswick County in honor of William M. Sue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names the I-140 bridge over U.S. 74/76 in Brunswick County as the *William M Sue Bridge*.

That appropriate signs will be erected at a suitable time.
