DOT GIS ArcMap Tools I Installation Instructions

It's very easy to install the ArcMap tools. Follow these steps:

- 1. Before you begin, make sure you have administration rights on the computer.
- 2. Before you begin, you must first uninstall a previously installed version of the tools. Selecting "Modify" on the installation menu does not update the application.
- 3. Before you may use the tools, ESRI ArcGIS Desktop (version 8.x) must be installed on the computer. It is recommended that ESRI ArcGIS Desktop be installed before installing these tools.
- 4. Obtain the installation program either from the DOT GIS Distribution Page (address) or from a distribution CD obtained from the GIS Unit. The installation program is called **InstallArcMapToolsI.exe**. Copy the program to anywhere on your hard drive. If you have the program on a CD you need not copy it to your hard drive unless you want to.
- 5. Find the program using Windows Explorer. In other words, remember where you copied it. Double click the file to start the program.
- 6. Follow the instructions on the screens. It takes only a minute or two to install the programs. The installation process may require one or more reboots of the computer.
 - If you encounter an error during the installation referencing sccrun.dll, ignore it. The tools should still work.
 - If you encounter any other errors during the installation, the tools may not function correctly. Contact your computer consultant if the installation did not successfully complete.
- 7. Once the program completes, the tools and other related files are installed on your computer and you may begin using them immediately.

At this point you may want to consult the <u>DOT GIS ArcMap Tools User Manual</u> which explains how to use the ArcMap tools, or the <u>Post-Installation Documentation – ArcMap GIS Tools I</u> manual which explains the installed files.
