

STIP Manager Report: Comprehensive STIP

NCDOT STIP

The N.C. Department of Transportation's long-range transportation plan – called the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) – identifies the construction funding and schedule for state transportation projects over a 10-year period. NCDOT updates the STIP approximately every two years. The data-driven process to update the STIP is called [Strategic Prioritization](#). For more information, visit [NCDOT's STIP web site](#).

Comprehensive STIP

STIP Manager provides the user with a web-based interface to view, enter, and edit data associated with the NCDOT Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Modules are included to allow users to add and manage projects, input funding information, and to process STIP revisions through an automated workflow. Additional reporting and analysis features are included.

The Comprehensive STIP report provides a detailed view of general and funding information for all projects in the STIP. The report lists projects with information formatted the same as the Simple Project Summary report, but without maps. Projects are grouped and sorted by County, Mode, and STIP ID. STIP and Revision filters are available as report configuration options.
