

STIP Manager Report: Fiscal Constraint Analysis

NCDOT STIP

The N.C. Department of Transportation's long-range transportation plan – called the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) – identifies the construction funding and schedule for state transportation projects over a 10-year period. NCDOT updates the STIP approximately every two years. The data-driven process to update the STIP is called [Strategic Prioritization](#). For more information, visit [NCDOT's STIP web site](#).

Fiscal Constraint Analysis

STIP Manager provides the user with a web-based interface to view, enter, and edit data associated with the NCDOT Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Modules are included to allow users to add and manage projects, input funding information, and to process STIP revisions through an automated workflow. Additional reporting and analysis features are included.

The File Constraint Analysis report allows a comparison of Estimated Revenues in an Adjusted Budget to Programmed Amounts by Fund Source across the 10-year STIP window. Funding Sources subject to Fiscal Constraint are grouped by Fund Type (Federal, State, Other) and listed alphabetically. Programmed Amounts are included for each Funding Source for each year in the STIP. STIP and Revision filters are available as report configuration options.
