Using the Locate Route Tool

1. Click on the **More** button to list additional application tools.
2. Click on **Draw Tool** to open the tool panel.
3. Select the type of graphic you want to draw. The available settings will vary depending on the selected draw mode.
4. Also add text using the "Text" draw mode.
5. Define a symbol for the graphic. Point symbols have several symbol set options.
6. Toggle on/off the option to display calculated length or area of the drawn graphics. The value is displayed on the map.
7. Click "Clear" to clear all text and graphics from the map.
8. Use "Undo" to remove the most recently drawn graphic or text.
