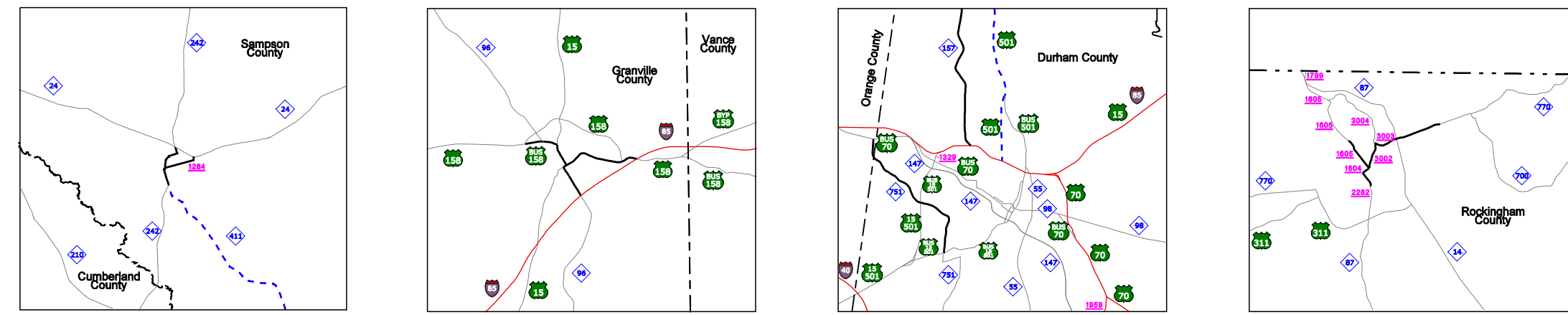
Western North Carolina Truck Advisory

Due to the frequency, severity and combination of grades, curves, and lane/shoulder limitations found throughout western North Carolina's mountains - single unit and pup (28 foot trailer) type delivery vehicle combinations that provide improved tracking and maneuverability should be considered.

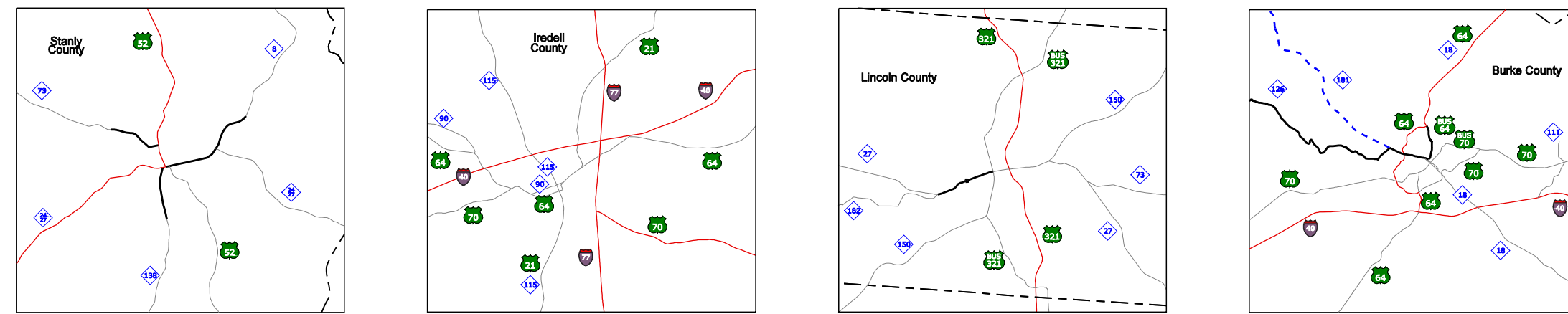
Pre-Trip surveillance and planning and the use of experienced safe drivers/operators familiar with western North Carolina's narrow, winding, and steep roads are strongly advised.



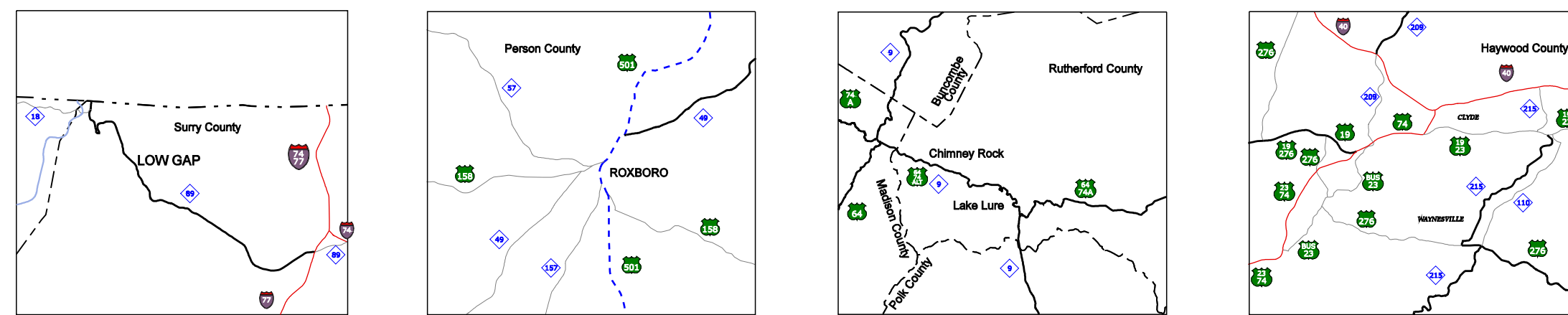
