A. Project Description, Location, and Purpose:

Additional Notes: Type I A

The purpose of this project is to replace Bridge No. 115 on SR 1601 (Sledge Road) over Rocky Swamp in Halifax County.

Bridge No. 115 is 68 feet in length. The replacement structure will be a bridge approximately 90 feet in length. The new bridge will have an approximately 30-foot 10-inch clear deck width with two 10-foot travel lanes and 5-foot 5-inch offsets on the existing alignment. The proposed right of way will span up to 85 feet. The total length of the project is approximately 590 feet in length.

There will be no posted weight restrictions; the proposed bridge will be designed to meet the legal load rating. The roadway is classified as a local route with a 55-mile per hour design speed.

The bridge will be replaced on the existing alignment while detouring traffic offsite.

Water Resources

The water resource classifications for the streams identified in the Categorical Exclusion remain accurate.

Protected Species

The list of protected species remain unchanged since the Categorical Exclusion was completed. No species have been added or removed for the county. There is no habitat for protected species within the study area.

Historic Architecture and Archaeology

NCDOT has reviewed the Section 106 effects findings for historic properties within the project's area of potential effects (APE), that were made as part of the NEPA analysis. NCDOT has confirmed that there is no new information that would alter the original Section 106 findings and, therefore, they remain valid.

E. Conclusion:

The above NEPA/SEPA documentation has been reevaluated (as required by either 23 CFR 771 or by NC General Statute Chapter 113A Article 1). COMMITMENTS FROM PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AND DESIGN

NCDOT Hydraulics Unit

The Hydraulics Unit coordinated with the NC Floodplain Mapping Program (FMP) on March 3, 2019 to determine status of project with regard to applicability of NCDOT's Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), or approval of a Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR) and subsequent final Letter of Map Revision (LOMR). The coordination resulted in approval on June 28, 2019 for the FEMA NFIP (National Flood Insurance Program) under NCDOT's MOA with the FMP.

The Tar-Pamlico River Basin Rule applies to this project. Riparian buffer impacts will be avoided and minimized.

NCDOT Environmental Analysis Unit

Section 7 was resolved for Dwarf wedgemussel and the Tar River spinymussel in the earlier part of 2020.

NCDOT Division 4 Construction, Resident Engineer's Office – FEMA

This project involves construction activities on or adjacent to FEMA-regulated stream(s). Therefore, the Division shall submit sealed as-built construction plans to the Hydraulics Unit upon completion of project construction, certifying that the drainage structure(s) and roadway embankment that are located within the 100-year floodplain were built as shown in the construction plans, both horizontally and vertically.

NCDOT Structures Management Unit - Public Involvement Newsletter

Newsletters were sent to the property owners affected by the project on March 21, 2019 to inform them of the project and the offsite detour.


NCDOT Division 4 – Schools and Emergency Management Services
