Dear Mr. Barrett:

On July 7, 2025 the Division of Water Resources (Division) received your application requesting a 401 Water Quality Certification and Buffer Approval from the Division for the subject project. On July 22, 2025, additional information was requested via email for the project. At this time, the Division has determined that your application is incomplete and cannot be processed. **The application is on-hold until all of the following information is received:**

1. Confirm Sheet 5 of the Permit drawings. At the end of the Project and east of NC 87, there is an off-site pond which appears to drain into the Project area. Please provide supporting information and data forms collected in this area.
2. Based on the Jurisdictional Features Map, stream SB and SC are located on-site.
3. Provide a topographic map and soil survey of the revised Project area.
4. Please label stream SB and Stream SC throughout the permit and buffer drawings.
5. Please provide the Stream ID forms collected for stream SB and SC.
6. Stream SC does not appear to be depicted on the permit drawings.

Pursuant to Title 15A NCAC 02H .0502(e) / Title 15A NCAC 02H .1304(d) / 15A NCAC 02B.0611, the applicant shall furnish all of the above requested information for the proper consideration of the application. Please respond in writing within 30 calendar days of receipt of this letter by sending one (1) copy of all of the above requested information to the 401 & Buffer Permitting Branch, 1617 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-1617 OR by submitting all of the above requested information through this link: <https://edocs.deq.nc.gov/Forms/Supplemental-Information-Form> (note the DWR# requested on the link is referenced above).
