1. Purpose of Meeting

The purpose of today's meeting is to discuss the alternatives to be studied in detail and review alignment. Concurrence will be requested at the January 2019 Merger Meeting. The desired outcome is to reach concurrence on one "best fit" alignment.

2. Project Description

The NCDOT proposes to widen NC 211 to a four-lane divided roadway with a grass median from US 15-501 in Aberdeen (Moore County) to east of SR 1244 (West Palmer Street) / SR 1311 (Mockingbird Hill Road) in Raeford (Hoke County), a distance of approximately 15.4 miles. The project study area and alternatives are shown on Figures 1-19.

The project is included in the 2018-2027 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and is state funded. Right of way acquisition and construction are scheduled for state fiscal years 2020 and 2023, respectively. The total cost for the project included in the 2018-2027 STIP is \$141,719,000. Of this total, \$42,356,000 is included for right of way acquisition, \$5,083,000 for utility relocation and \$94,280,000 for construction.

3. Project Status

A Minimum Criteria Determination Checklist or State Environmental Assessment will be prepared in compliance with North Carolina's State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA). Two public meetings were held in July 2016 to introduce the project, discuss the project need, and present the draft study area. Approximately 150 people attended the meetings.

A combined Concurrence Point 1 / Concurrence Point 2 meeting was held on June 15, 2017. The following sections summarize the meeting results.

4.1. Concurrence Point 1

Following the merger meeting and with additional email collaboration, the Project Team concurred on the purpose and need, screening criteria, and study area for the project. Electronic signatures were obtained.

Project Purpose: The purpose of the proposed project is to reduce traffic congestion and travel delays, and correct roadway deficiencies along NC 211 within the project limits.

Screening Criteria: The following performance measures explain how alternatives that meet the Purpose stated above will be evaluated. Specifically, alternatives considered for the project must achieve the following along NC 211 within the project limits:

- provide additional traffic capacity in order to achieve a level of service "C" or better for the NC 211 roadway (mainline) segments during the peak hours in 2040;
- improve traffic operations by reducing travel delays and queue lengths and achieving an overall level of service "D" or better at signalized intersections during the peak hours in 2040;
- improve NC 211's horizontal and vertical alignment, clear zones and sight distance to reduce, mitigate or eliminate existing design deficiencies; and
- provide at least minimum acceptable standards for lane and shoulder widths based on the current NCDOT Roadway Design Manual.

Secondary Benefits: Additional benefits of the proposed project include:

- potential traffic safety improvements by reducing the number and type of conflict points as compared to the existing conditions and
- operational improvements by providing the opportunity for motorists to pass slower-moving or stopped vehicles.

4.2. Concurrence Point 2

Options for widening NC 211 on either side of the roadway were presented at the June 2017 merger meeting, as well as options for grade-separated railroad crossings and/or the realignment of intersecting roadways. The widening options were presented in 15 sections for evaluation individually. Selected options could be combined to provide an overall "best fit" alternative, in addition to asymmetrical widening.

At the merger meeting, those present concurred on widening options to be studied in detail and signed the concurrence form. However, the concurrence form has not been signed by all merger team members. (USACE, HPO, and FAMPO representatives did not attend the meeting and have not signed the original form.)

The following decisions were made at the merger meeting regarding alternatives to carry forward: [those present concurred]

Typical Section

NC 211 would be widened to a four-lane, median divided facility. The typical section would include:

- A 30-foot wide, raised grass-median with use of a curb and gutter section is anticipated through Aberdeen and Moore County where more residential and commercial development is located close to the existing roadway. Bicycle lanes are proposed, consistent with the Aberdeen Bicycle Plan.
- A 46-foot wide, depressed grass-median shoulder section is anticipated from the Moore/Hoke County line to the eastern project limit.

Alternatives

Following discussion of each section and option, several were eliminated from further consideration. However, more than one widening option was carried forward for 10 of the 15 project sections. The alternatives carried forward are shown in Table 1.

4. Concurrence Point 2 (Revisited): Detailed Study Alternatives Carried Forward

Preliminary design was completed for primary widening to the north side of NC 211 and to the south side of NC 211 with design options noted in Table 1. Because the high number of potential combinations of options, further refinement is requested. Additional detail is provided in order to determine a "best fit" alternative.

Preliminary impacts have been calculated for each section/option carried forward. Table 2 provides a comparison of the design options and is located in Appendix A while Figures 1-19 are included in Appendix B and design year traffic volumes are illustrated in Appendix C. The original identification of design options to carry forward are highlighted in green while additional recommendations for identifying the best fit alternative are highlighted in yellow.

The preliminary design includes superstreet concepts and access management along the project (e.g., use of right-in/right-out and consolidation of access points where access is also available along another roadway or a second access point is located along NC 211).

5. Concurrence Point 2A: Bridging Decisions and Alignment Review

Bridging Decisions

A Hydraulic Technical Report was completed for the project (April 2017, RK&K). There are no existing or proposed bridges along NC 211 within the project limits. A summary of the preliminary hydraulic recommendations is included in Appendix D.

Alignment Review

NC 211 does not currently meet design speed (50 MPH in Moore County and 60 MPH in Hoke County) in 37 locations due to the existing vertical alignment (sags and crests) and in 1 location due to the existing horizontal alignment, as detailed in Appendix E. The proposed improvements in all the design options, correct those deficiencies.

Leadership of the Ashley Heights Baptist Church (referenced by asterisks (*) above) is <u>not</u> impacted and they have enough land remaining to build a new multi-use building.

The current study area boundary stops short of providing NRTR coverage in the vicinity of Stream SC in Section 1; and Stream SH within Section 11. A preliminary estimate was used to approximate the size/location of SC, WP, WQ and SH outside of the study area boundary. Stream SJ in Section 6 is in the process of being assessed for a potential extension of the stream along Arthur Lane.
