The Project Development and Environmental Analysis Unit is starting the project development, environmental and engineering studies for the subject project in the City of Greensboro from SR 2254 (Wendover Avenue) to Holden Road. The proposed project would add lanes to Benjamin Parkway/Bryan Boulevard. The existing roadway is a multi-lane, median divided, boulevard with 3-northbound travel lanes and 2-southbound travel lanes. This project is approximately 1.2 miles long. The project is included in the current NCDOT 10 Year Work Program. Right of way acquisition is scheduled for state fiscal year 2020 and construction let in state fiscal year 2022.

An Internal/External Scoping Meeting has been scheduled on August 17, 2017 from 3:15 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. The meeting will be held in the NCDOT Structure Design Conference Room, in Building A, Century Center, 1000 Birch Ridge Road in Raleigh.
