As indicated in the tables, there are 13 linear feet of impacts to streams and 6,627 square feet of impacts to riparian buffers. There are no impacts to wetlands. The project at this time has a Let Date of November 21, 2006. Therefore, NCDOT respectfully requests that the referenced Section 404 NW 23/33 permits be renewed. We also respectfully request that the referenced 401 WQC and Catawba River Buffer Authorization be renewed. The project has not changed. Therefore, all previously submitted permit drawings and plan sheets are current. All environmental commitments and special conditions referenced in the NW 23/33 Permit Application will continue to be followed throughout project construction.
