This request is for Transportation Improvement Project No. B-2500, the replacement of Bridge no. 11 over the Oregon Inlet in Dare County. Please see attached mapping of approximate transects. A hydrography crew will run north-south transects from a 28' boat across Oregon Inlet and Pamlico Sound in order to ascertain inlet current flows and bathymetric depths. This data is being collected for final design parameters. The crew(s) will launch from the NPS Oregon Inlet boat launch daily, with no overnight use. They will monitor channel 16 radio traffic and scan for traffic on a 2nd radio. They will coordinate via radio with other vessels to make sure they do not interfere with existing traffic.


