Four (4) borings will occur on the Bayview side and four(4) on the Aurora side. The bores consist of casing measures approximately 6-inches in diameter. The borings will be performed from a barge (photo attached). The barges will be secured below the mudline with four (4) spuds that are 3-inches in diameter.
