Dear Sir,

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) proposes to install conduit containing fiber optic cable along U.S. 74 within the existing NCDOT right-of-way in Brunswick County. It is proposed that three conduits will be installed, each having a 1.25-inch diameter. One stream, Hood Creek, was identified as Public Trust Waters and subject to the Coastal Area Management Act. This resource is located within the Cape Fear River basin

Please see enclosed the Division of Coastal Management Major Permit Form 1 and permit drawing for the above referenced project.

This project had a Design Build letting date of March 26, 2021.

It is anticipated that there will be no impacts to streams or coastal wetlands with this project.

Regulatory Approvals

<u>CAMA General Permit</u>: NCDOT requests that the proposed work be authorized under a Coastal Area Management Act General Permit. Adjacent riparian landowner certified mail return receipts will be provided once they are received. 
