The total length of the project is approximately 7.0 miles and includes a bridge over Maple Swamp on the Currituck County mainland and a bridge over Currituck Sound. In addition, the project includes improvement to US 158 (both in Currituck and Dare Counties) and NC 12 (in Currituck County).
