Location description: The project area is along US 17/74/76 from the NC 133/SR 1472 interchange to the US 421/NC 133 interchange crossing Brunswick River and Alligator Creek near the Cape Fear River floodplain in Brunswick County.

Description of projects area and activity: The NCDOT propose to widen the aforementioned stretch of road from four to six lanes which also involves the replacement of bridges over the Brunswick River and Alligator Creek. Additionally, the northbound bridge will be the start of an additional seventh lane that will continue on US 17 into Wilmington. This reverfication covers 0.05 of an acre of temporary fill in wetlands and 0.11 of an acre of hand clearing in wetlands to accommodate a temporary work bridge (10' wide expansion) to construct permanent structure # 107 at site # 10.

The temporary fill area should be restored to its former elevation and appropriately stabilized with a riparian seed mix when the temporary bridge is removed.

- 1. All of the authorized activities and written conditions of the certification associated with the original Water Quality Certification dated May 16, 2013 and subsequent modification dated July 14, 2014; March 27, 2015 and September 15, 2015 still apply except where superseded by this certification.
- 2. Temporary fill placed in wetlands at Site 10 shall be placed on geotextile fabric, removed in its entirety and the natural grade restored upon completion of the project. [15A NCAC 02H.0506(b)(3) and (c)(3)]

Dear Mr. Hancock:

This letter is in response to your letter dated September 21, 2015, including two (2) revised drawings dated September 20, 2015. The letter requests authorization to revise the construction plans for the above referenced project to allow expansion of the authorized work bridge adjacent to Structure 107 by ten additional feet to the south. The letter also indicates that the N.C. Department of Transportation (NCDOT) proposes to place an additional 0.03 acres of temporary fill in Section 404 Wetlands to expand the authorized causeway for work bridge access at Site 10. The letter also indicates that approximately 0.07 acres of additional hand clearing in Section 404 Wetlands will be required for construction of the work bridge.

Please be advised that through this Letter of Refinement the N.C. Division of Coastal Management (DCM) conveys its determination that the proposed revisions are consistent with existing State rules and regulations and are in keeping with the original purpose and intent of CAMA Major Permit No. 89-13. This letter shall be attached to the original CAMA Permit No. 89-13 which was issued on August 2, 2013, as well as all subsequent modifications and letters of refinement, and all documents shall be readily available on site when a DCM representative inspects the project for compliance. All conditions and stipulations of the active permit remain in force unless altered herein. This approval does not eliminate the need to obtain any additional permits, approvals, or authorizations that may be required.




