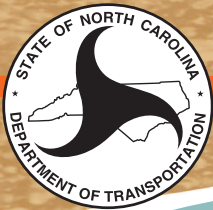
Bridge No. 29 over Cub Creek on Oakwood Road (SR 1001) will be replaced along a new alignment to the west (toward Cub Creek Park). During construction of the new bridge, Oakwood Road will be closed for a period up to six months to allow for the new bridge to be constructed and the new alignment to be tied into the existing.

During the closure of Oakwood Road, traffic will be detoured along US 421, NC 18, and NC 18/268 (Main Street). Access to Edgewood road will be provided from the south with a temporary entrance alignment away from the construction zone.

The existing structure will be widened to include two travel lanes, bike lanes, and a protected pedestrian walkway. The structure will be raised to allow for a greenway access under the bridge along the north side of Cub Creek.

The final footprint for the project will require acquisition of park property protected by Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966 as well as Section 6(f) of the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965, as amended. NCDOT is seeking a de minimis determination for the Section 4 (f) impact as well as purchasing conversion property for the replacement of Section 6 (f) property impacted by this project located along the western side of Cub Creek Park.
