



NCDOT has recently met to discuss the resolutions the Wilksboro Town Council furnished us from the October meeting. During our meeting, we focused on two of the resolutions. We noted the desire for a separation between the pedestrian traffic and vehicular traffic. We agree that this would provide for more safety and NCDOT is revising our plans to leave the existing pedestrian bridge as is and to not include pedestrians on the new structure.

We also discussed the issue of a below grade crossing for the future extension of the Greenway system. Preliminary hydraulic studies of the area have provided us with information that shows the area underneath the proposed structure to be insufficient for a Greenway passage. Therefore, at this time, we are unable to provide for a Greenway access. We suggest that once the Wilksboro Town Council has adopted a greenway plan in the area you contact Robert Mosher, AICP, ASLA of the NC Bicycle and Pedestrian Division to discuss the possibility of an "atgrade" signalized pedestrian crossing.

In regard to the above referenced bridge replacement at Oakwoods Road (NCSR 1001) over Cub Creek, Wilkesboro, NC, please consider the following:

Re-align NCSR 1001 to eliminate the sharp, declining curve preceding the bridge heading east. The curve has been the site of many traffic accidents and is a highly traveled roadway linking US Hwy. 421 to each of the Wilkesboros.

By realigning the road, the location of the replacement bridge would be west of the current bridge. The current bridge could be used during the construction of the new bridge, eliminating a congestive detour on Main Street, Wilkesboro for at least 9 months.

No buildings are located in the area needed for such realignment, therefore, right of way acquisition costs should be reasonable.

Perhaps you are considering such a realignment and that is certainly progressive planning. However, if the bridge is replaced in it's current location, without remedying the sharp curve, it would be shortsighted, dangerous and poor use of the proposed \$1.08 million currently budgeted for the work. Please consider this realignment.

The NCDOT proposes to replace Bridge No. 29 on Oakwoods Road (SR 1001) over Cub Creek. The bridge replacement is necessary to maintain the safety of those travelling this route as the existing structure, built in 1969, is nearing the end of its useful life.

The NCDOT is currently conducting engineering and environmental studies to determine the most economical and environmentally sound method for replacing the existing bridge. The preferred alternative being studied will replace the existing bridge at its current location. The proposed bridge will be wide enough to accommodate two lanes of traffic. Traffic will be maintained using an offsite detour during construction, which is anticipated to last approximately nine months. The studied offsite detour includes NC 18/NC 268, NC 18 and US 421.

The NCDOT is aware that citizens living in the proposed project area want to know the potential effects of the project on their homes and lifestyles. However, exact information is not available at this stage in the planning process. Additional design work will be performed before the actual right-of-way limits can be established. This newsletter is to inform the public of the replacement of bridge 29 and solicit your input on the project. 


VIEW OF EXISTING BRIDGE LOOKING EAST


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
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VIEW OF EXISTING BRIDGE LOOKING EAST


- City is developing new driveway access to park onto SR 1001. City will forward plans when they are further along.
- According to the City the Yadkin River Greenway will be crossing near the bridge. They would like to incorporate this into the bridge and cross underneath the bridge. The City is going to send a request to that effect. Kathy will also send a letter from DENR/NC State.
- The County has property adjacent to some of the city property and they may be willing to donate that property for the conversion.
- No preference on either alternate.

These are just some of the key points I wrote down.



Per our meeting last Thursday we went back and revised Alt.A. Previously we showed curb & gutter with proposed sidewalk on the right hand side including sidewalk on the bridge. In this revision we utilized a 4' paved shoulder on the right hand side (see typical and xs) and maintained the existing sidewalk. Please see the attached .pdf files. I think we could do this without a retaining wall.

The only negative I see with the above is that there is not positive drainage from where the proposed fill slope ties in to the existing sidewalk (see xs). Coinsidering that we also looked at replacing the sidewalk in a seperate option. I am going to send those .pdf files seperately.

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
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
